 $You \ determine \ your \ budget \ results \ by \ subtracting \ the \ total \ budget \ available \ from \ the \ total \ spend.$

- If the budget result is \$0, that means you spent the exact amount you had available.
- If the budget result is negative (below \$0), that means you spent more than the total funds available. Try finding areas where you can save money or expenses you can cut out entirely.
- If the budget result is positive (above \$0), you've got money left over! That's great news if you want to splurge a bit
 more on your honeymoon or boost your savings for a down payment on your dream house after the wedding.
